

What is Positive Behavior Support?

PBS is a school-wide program that systematically works to improve students' behavior using best practices which have been proven effective.

This program is built on the premise that if basic behavior expectations are taught and reinforced, behavior will improve.

PBS also uses existing discipline data to guide changes in the environment of the school. These changes are then evaluated for their effectiveness in making improvements in behavior.
